



## **Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA)**

### **Subject: Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 47)**

Reference is made to the implementation by the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) in accordance with the Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 36) dated 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021 and (No. 37) dated 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021 by issuing the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 45) dated 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and (No. 46) dated 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to have premises temporarily closed and complied with the said Announcement until 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 or until further notice.

In order to have continuous implementation on integrated area disease control and prevention measures and relax measures for some premises so that they can operate or organize some activities under conditions, time clause, systematic arrangement and regulations and disease prevention measures prescribed by the Government and to operate the driving of economy together with imposing integrated area disease control and prevention measures under the said Regulation, by the virtue of Section 34 and Section 35 (1) of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015), and Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 30) dated 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021, (No. 36) dated 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021 and (No. 37) dated 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021, Governor of Bangkok, with the approval of the BMA Communicable Diseases Committee as stated in the Meeting Resolution No. 33/2564 dated 26<sup>th</sup> November 2021, shall have the orders as follows:

1. Premises shall be temporarily closed as follows:

1.1 Entertainment venues, any establishments providing similar services to those of entertainment venues, amusement places, pubs, bars, karaoke shops or other similar venues;

1.2 Massage parlors.

2. Premises, businesses or activities granted the ease of restrictions to be opened or operated under the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 45) dated 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021 Clause 2, Clause 3, Clause 4, Clause 5, and Clause 6, and the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 46) dated 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021 Clause 1, can be further opened or operated by complying with measures prescribed in the said Announcements so long as they are not contrary to or inconsistent with this Announcement.

Shops selling food or beverage can be opened for on-premises dining services is allowed by their regular time. Consumption of liquor and alcoholic drinks is allowed until 11.00 p.m. only at the venues that have passed the test and assessment according to the Amazing Thailand Safety & Health Administration at the SHA level of the Ministry of Tourism and Sports prescribed by the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) or the COVID-19 prevention safety standard called Thai Stop COVID Plus prescribed by Department of Health.

3. Other ...

3. Other premises apart from Clause 2, which were ordered to be temporarily closed and granted the ease of restrictions by this Announcement can be opened for operations with strict compliance under conditions, time clause, systematic arrangement and regulations and disease prevention measures prescribed by the Government such as DMHTTA measure, universal prevention measures, COVID Free Setting as well as measures under laws on communicable diseases specially enacted by relating agencies, and shall be permitted for operating businesses under relating laws.

Any persons who violate or fail to comply with this Order shall be guilty of an offense under Section 51 of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015) which shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand Baht or Section 52 which shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand Baht or to both, as the case may be, and shall be guilty of an offense under Section 18 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (2005) which shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to a fine not exceeding forty thousand Baht or to both.

As this is a case where there is urgent necessity and the delay of action may cause great harm to any individual or affect the public interest, litigants shall not be given the right to object under section 30 paragraph two (1) of the Administrative Procedure Act, B.E. 2539 (1996).

This Order shall take effect between 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 or until further notice.
